

## FAQs: Advocate Health Group Membership Program with State Nurses Associations and ANA

### What is being offered?

Advocate Health is offering the opportunity for registered nurse employees to join their State Nurses Association and the [American Nurses Association](#) (ANA) using your Educational Assistance Benefit funds, plus 1.0 free CE to start! Participation is dependent on having available Educational Assistance funds.

This opportunity is open to registered nurse employees who live and/or work in Georgia ([Georgia Nurses Association](#)), Illinois ([American Nurses Association Illinois](#)), North Carolina ([North Carolina Nurses Association](#)) and Wisconsin ([Wisconsin Nurses Association](#)).

### What if I am already a member of my State Nursing Association (GNA, ANA-Illinois, NCNA or WNA) and/or ANA?

All current members are eligible for this Advocate Health group membership opportunity. Existing members who pay annually will have their prorated membership period extended beyond the point when their Advocate Health-provided membership expires. For members who pay monthly, payments will stop when the Advocate Health membership begins on August 1, 2026.

### What if I am already an Atrium Health group member because I enrolled in the Atrium Health group membership program in North Carolina (NCNA/ANA) or Georgia (GNA/ANA) in 2025?

You will need to participate in this year's enrollment process to maintain your active membership. Follow the enrollment process described below in the "How does it work?" section.

### How does it work?

1. Start your enrollment in the group membership program by going to the [Advocate Health Nursing Portal](#) and selecting the link to your State Nurses Association. **The enrollment period is May 6 to June 30, 2026.**
2. Follow the enrollment steps on your State Nurses Association site including completing 1.0 CE.  
*\*Note: you must select one of the courses offered by your State Association on their enrollment site for your enrollment to be complete.*
3. Once you complete the CE, enrollment form and course evaluation on the State Association site, Advocate Health will utilize your Educational Assistance Benefit funds to pay for your membership.
4. **Complete these steps by June 30, 2026**, to be enrolled in this opportunity.
5. Your membership begins on August 1, and you receive access to all benefits your State Nursing Association and ANA offer!
