

Conflict of Interest

Purpose

To avoid an appearance of conflict of interest for members of the Board of Directors and for all individuals who serve in ANA-Illinois offices (elected and appointed positions including committees) (collectively "ANA-Illinois Persons").

Policy

All ANA-Illinois Persons shall scrupulously avoid any conflict between their own respective individual interests and the interests of ANA-Illinois in any and all actions taken by them on behalf of ANA-Illinois.

To assist in avoiding any conflict or appearance of conflict of interest:

- 1. When any interest on the part of ANA-Illinois Persons poses a possible conflict with the ANA-Illinois Person's responsibilities, the ANA-Illinois Person shall:
 - a. Promptly call the conflict to the attention of the other ANA-Illinois Persons who are participating or voting on the matter which poses the possible conflict; and
 - b. Abstain from participation in discussion or voting on such matter. The official minutes of any meeting at which a disclosure of conflict was made shall reflect said disclosure and that the ANA-Illinois Person abstained from any participation in the matter.
- 2. Each ANA-Illinois Person shall annually read the "Conflict of Interest" Confidential Disclosure Statement and complete and return the attached confidential statement to the ANA-Illinois Executive Director, who will maintain such statement in a confidential file available only to the President of the Board of Directors, and to such other persons as either of them may direct, including, as appropriate, the external auditors of ANA-Illinois.
- The ANA-Illinois Executive Director and ANA-Illinois Legal Counsel shall assist individual members of the Board of Directors in making the determination whether they meet the definitions of conflict of interest.
